The time has come for us to identify Teen Leaders that will be working with us as Teen Facilitators for the remainder of the 2009 - 2010 school year. Included with this letter is a packet of information that provides a job description and application for the position.

In addition to the completed application, to qualify for one of the positions you must:

- Be able to attend group interview (date in July/August to be determined).
- Have and maintain a GPA of at least a 3.0 (a copy of your most recent report card must be submitted with application)
- Be or become an active member in PEARLS Teen Group
- Attend and participate in Team Planning Sessions (weekly)
- Attend and participate in all staff meetings (monthly)
- Attend mandatory facilitator training (dates to be determined)
- Actively assist and partner with site team to facilitate planned activities with girls.

When considering the position, make sure that you get a good understanding of what it requires *before* applying. We want this to be a good experience for you, the girls we serve, and PEARLS. That begins by knowing what's expected of you and deciding if it's something you are really interested and able to do.
